

FHCI Course Selection Information for Students In Grade 9 in 2025-2026

Students can use this “cheat sheet” to plan their course selections for next year - this includes selecting 8 courses (which is 8.0 credits). Talk to your parents, teachers, and guidance counsellor. Use this information to help you plan, then finalize your Grade 9 program. You must log into myBlueprint and complete course selections in the system with the proper course codes. Parents must approve course selections.

Grade 9 Core Compulsory Program: Most students will take FIVE (5) compulsory core courses, resulting in 5 credits
